**Supporting Asylum Link Merseyside** – Thank you for your generous donations to Asylum Link—your support truly makes a difference to those in need.

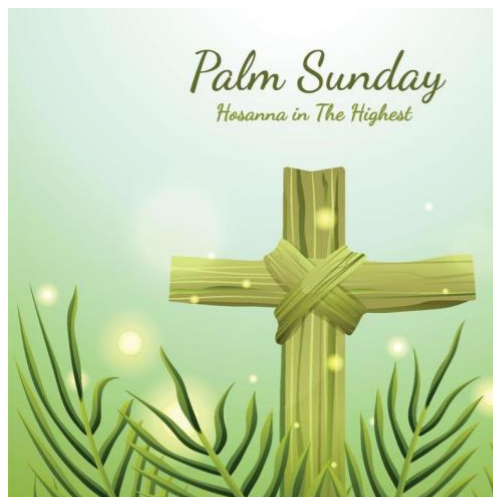
